

RESOLUTION NO. 1992-10

AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO RESOLUTION 1991-220 MODIFYING THE FUNDING FOR ARCHITECT/ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR PROJECT 24E AND 24F REHABILITATION OF W. 117TH & MADISON AND W. 98TH & DETROIT RED LINE STATIONS FROM CAPITAL GRANT OH-03-0104 (\$1,094,630.00) TO CAPITAL GRANTS OH-90-0068 (\$795,936.00) AND OH-90-0073 (\$298,694.00); \$875,704.00 IN FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS 80% OF THE TOTAL PRICE

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 1991-220 the Board authorized a contract with Whitley/Baker Associates for Architect/Engineering Services for the rehabilitation of the W. 117th and Madison and the W. 98th and Detroit Red Line Rapid Transit Stations; and

WHEREAS, Section 3 of said resolution states that said contract shall be payable from Capital Grant OH-03-0104, 75% of said contract (\$820,972.50); and RTA local match funds, 25% of said contract (\$273,657.50); and

WHEREAS, the reallocation of available grant funding is necessary to accommodate the needs of the Authority.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager be and he is hereby authorized to pay said contract out of Capital Grant OH-90-0068 in the amount of seven hundred ninety-five thousand nine hundred thirty-six dollars (\$795,936.00) and Capital Grant OH-90-0073 in the amount of two hundred ninety-eight thousand six hundred ninety-four dollars (\$298,694.00) of which eight hundred seventy-five thousand seven hundred four dollars (\$875,704.00) is federal funds, representing eighty percent (80%) of the total cost.

Section 2. that all other provisions of Resolution 1991-220 shall remain unchanged.

Section 3. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
