

RESOLUTION NO. 1992- 11

AUTHORIZING THE USE OF TOWER CITY CAPITAL RESERVE ACCOUNT TO PAY AMOUNTS PROPERLY DUE, OR TO BECOME DUE, TO THE CANNON PARTNERSHIP UNDER ITS CONTRACT IN AN ESTIMATED AMOUNT OF \$225,000.00.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees by Resolution No. 1986-45 previously authorized the General Manager to enter into a contract with the Cannon Partnership for architectural and engineering services for the rehabilitation of the Tower City Station;

WHEREAS, Resolutions 1987-337, 1988-118, 1990-11, 1990-24, and 1990-125 authorized changes to the Cannon contract;

WHEREAS, funds for this contract were derived from Federal Grants OH-90-0073, OH-23-9001, and OH-90-0001; and

WHEREAS, the remaining amounts in these grants do not contain sufficient fund balances to complete the scope of services required for the Tower City Station project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager be and he is hereby authorized to pay amounts properly due under the Cannon Partnership contract and in excess of funds available in said grants out of the Tower City Capital City Reserve Account in an estimated amount of two hundred twenty-five thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$225,000.00).

Section 2. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
