AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 1990-70, ADOPTING AND APPROVING REVISED TEMPORARY SERVICE POLICY HEADWAYS

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees, acting through Resolution No. 1990-70, on April 17, 1990, adopted and approved a Service Policy for the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Service Policy established a sixty-minute minimum frequency of service as the maximum policy headway for fixed-route bus service; and

WHEREAS, the sixty-minute minimum service frequency established as the maximum policy headway does not allow for flexibility in considering viable service options that more efficiently and cost-effectively match service to demand.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1: That Resolution No. 1990-70 adopted April 17, 1990, be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

4.4.3. Policy headways

- A. Fixed-route bus service should be scheduled to insure that:
 - o The minimum frequency of service to be maintained along the trunk segment of any fixed route will be the amount of time required for one bus to complete a round trip, but in no event shall the time exceed one-hundred twenty (120) minutes.
 - o To the maximum extent possible, route branches will have equal headways and there will be a uniform headway along the trunk segment.
- B. Rail services will have the following maximum headways:

 $\underline{\text{Section 2}}\colon$ That all other provisions of Resolution No. 1990-70 shall remain in $\overline{\text{effect.}}$
