

RESOLUTION 1992- 49

**AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH BUCKEYE BUSINESS PRODUCTS,
INC. FOR THE FURNISHING OF COMPUTER PAPER FOR A PERIOD
OF TWO (2) YEARS (EST. \$38,966.10) GENERAL FUND -
INVENTORY DEPARTMENT BUDGET**

WHEREAS, the bid of Buckeye Business Products located at 3830 Kelly Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio for the furnishing of computer paper, Items 3 and 4 of Bid Package 91151, was received on the 2nd of April, 1992 for a price set forth in said bid, involving an estimated expenditure of thirty-eight thousand nine hundred sixty-six & 10/100 (\$38,966.10) dollars; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Buckeye Business Products, Inc. to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Buckeye Business Products, Inc. for the furnishing of computer paper, Item 3 (3 Ply NCR 14-7/8" x 11 x 1/2" Green Bar Stock Paper), and Item 4 (4 Ply NCR 14-7/8" x 11 x 1/2" Green Bar Stock Paper), of Bid Package 91151, be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for a period of two (2) years with Buckeye Business Products, Inc. for the furnishing of computer paper, Item 3 (3 Ply NCR 14-7/8" x 11 x 1/2" Green Bar Stock Paper), and Item 4 (4 Ply NCR 14-7/8" x 11 x 1/2" Green Bar Stock Paper), of Bid Package 91151 at an amount not to exceed thirty eight thousand nine hundred sixty-six & 10/100 dollars (\$38,966.10).

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund (Inventory Department Budget) in an amount not to exceed thirty-eight thousand nine hundred sixty-six & 10/100 dollars (\$38,966.10).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon appropriations for future contract years and upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
