

RESOLUTION NO. 1992-51

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH CENTRAL PAVING INCORPORATED FOR THE FURNISHING OF PAVEMENT DEMOLITION, SITE REMOVAL OF DEBRIS, AND CONSTRUCTION OF CONCRETE ROADWAYS AND WALKS AT WINDERMERE AND CEDAR ROADWAYS (\$100,399.50, RTA CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND)

WHEREAS, the bid of Central Paving Incorporated located at 7701 Commerce Park Oval, Cleveland, Ohio 44131 for the furnishing of pavement demolition, site removal of debris, and construction of concrete roadways and walks at Windermere and Cedar Roadways was received on the 15th day of April 1992 for a price set forth in said bid of one hundred thousand three hundred ninety-nine & 50/100 dollars (\$100,399.50); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Central paving Incorporated to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Central Paving Incorporated received on April 15, 1992 be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.


Section 2. That the General Manager be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Central Paving, Incorporated for the furnishing of pavement demolition, site removal of debris, and construction of concrete roadways and walks at Windermere and Cedar Roadways.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the RTA Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed one hundred thousand three hundred ninety nine & 50/100 dollars (\$100,399.50).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon appropriations for future years; compliance by the contractor to Bid Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements, and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
