

RESOLUTION 1992-61

**AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH DAVID CORPORATION
FOR THE FURNISHING OF SOFTWARE TO IMPLEMENT WORKERS'
COMPENSATION SYSTEM, AS SPECIFIED, FOR A TOTAL
EXPENDITURE OF (\$41,993.00 - RTA CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT
FUND) DATA SYSTEMS DEPARTMENT BUDGET**

WHEREAS, the bid of DAVID Corporation located at 1400 Ohio Savings Plaza, Cleveland, Ohio 44114, for the furnishing of software to implement workers' compensation system, as specified, was received on April 20, 1992 for a price set forth in said bid involving a total expenditure of forty-one thousand nine hundred ninety-three & 00/100 dollars (\$41,993.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of DAVID Corporation to be a responsible bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of DAVID Corporation received on April 20, 1992 be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with DAVID Corporation for the furnishing of software to implement workers' compensation system.


Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the RTA Capital Improvement Fund in a total amount not to exceed forty-one thousand nine hundred ninety-three & 00/100 dollars (\$41,993.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon appropriations for future years, compliance by the contract or to Bid Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements, and all applicable laws relating immediately upon its adoption.
