

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH WILLIAMS DETROIT DIESEL-ALLISON FOR THE FURNISHING OF REBUILT FUEL INJECTORS, AS REQUIRED FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR FOR AN ESTIMATED EXPENDITURE OF \$69,760.00 (GENERAL FUND, INVENTORY DEPARTMENT BUDGET).

WHEREAS, the bid of Williams Detroit Diesel-Allison located at 1176 Industrial Parkway, Brunswick, Ohio 44212, for the furnishing of rebuilt diesel fuel injectors, as required, was received on the 24th day of April, 1992, for the prices set forth in said bid involving an estimated expenditure of sixty-nine thousand seven hundred sixty & 00/100 dollars (\$69,760.00); and

WHEREAS, this procurement is divisible;

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Williams Detroit Diesel-Allison for Items 1 (OEM No. 5229790 - DDEC), 2 (OEM No. 5229895 - DDEC), 3 (OEM No. 52261701 - DDEC), 4 (OEM No. 5226510 - DDEC) 6 (OEM No. R5234915 DDEC) and 8 (GCRTA No. 87-19200 DDEC) of IFB No. 92032 to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Williams Detroit Diesel-Allison for Items 1, 2, 4, 6 and 8 of IFB No. 92032 be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Williams Detroit Diesel-Allison for the furnishing of rebuilt diesel fuel injector, as required, for a period of one (1) year.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund, (Inventory Department Budget) in an estimated amount not to exceed sixty-nine thousand seven hundred sixty & 00/100 dollars (\$69,760.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon appropriations for future contract years and upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in RESolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.
