

RESOLUTION 1992- 83

**AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH LAKESIDE COPY & BLUEPRINT, INC. FOR THE FURNISHING OF BULK REPROGRAPHIC SERVICES, PROJECT 3.92 - AS REQUIRED FOR A PERIOD OF TWO (2) YEARS FOR AN ESTIMATED EXPENDITURE OF \$39,859.50 FUNDED BY THE FOLLOWING FOUR (4) FEDERAL GRANTS (75% - 25%), OH-03-0104 (\$18,733.96); OH-03-0113, (1,594.38); OH-03-0115 (\$11,559.26); AND OH-03-0097 (\$7,971.90). OF THE TOTAL CONTRACT EXPENDITURE, \$9,964.86 IS TO BE FUNDED BY RTA LOCAL MATCH FUNDS**

WHEREAS, the bid of Lakeside Copy & Blueprint, Inc., located at 4507 Lorain Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio 44102 to furnish bulk reprographic services, Project 3.92, as required, for a period of two (2) years was received on the 10th of April, 1992 for the price set forth in said bid of thirty-nine thousand eight hundred fifty-nine & 50/100 dollars (\$39,859.50); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Lakeside Copy & Blueprint, Inc. to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Lakeside Copy & Blueprint, Inc. be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Lakeside Copy & Blueprint, Inc., to furnish bulk reprographic services, Project 3.92, as required, for a period of two (2) years.


Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the following Capital Grants: OH-03-0104, (\$18,733.96); OH-03-0113 (\$1,594.38); OH-03-0115 (\$11,559.26); and OH-03-0097 (\$7,971.90) for a total expenditure of thirty nine thousand eight hundred fifty-nine & 50/100 dollars (\$39,859.50); and RTA Local Match Funds of nine thousand nine hundred sixty four & 86/100 dollars (\$9,964.86).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent for future contract years upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

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Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
