RESOLUTION 1992–91

AUTHORIZING A SOLE SOURCE CONTRACT WITH DIGITAL CORPORATION FOR THE FURNISHING OF COMPUTER TERMINALS, PRINTERS, SUPPORTING EQUIPMENT AND CABLES (RTA CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND - \$79,667.45)

WHEREAS, the Computer Terminals, Printers, Supporting Equipment and Cables are necessary to expand the Authority's digital computers that are available through Digital Equipment Corporation located at 3201 Enterprise Parkway, Beachwood, Ohio 44122, the original manufacturer of the Authority's mainframe computer.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code Section 306.43(c) provides that competitive bidding is not required when a purchase consists of data processing services, the renewal or renegotiation of a lease of electronic data processing services or systems or for updated data processing services, or systems as supplied by the original source or its successors or assigns.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a sole source contract with Digital Equipment Corporation for the furnishing of computer terminals, printers, supporting equipment and cables to expand the Authority's digital computer system.

Section 2. That said contract shall be payable out of the RTA Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed seventy-nine thousand six hundred sixty seven & 45/100 dollars (\$79,667.45).

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority and contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Specification, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligation of the authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
