

RESOLUTION NO. 1992-99

**AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH NATIONAL INDUSTRIAL & EPOXY COATINGS CORPORATION FOR THE FURNISHING OF REPAIRS TO THE SPALLED FLOOR AND CORRECTION OF THE DRAINAGE PROBLEM AT THE SERVICE BUILDING (\$63,240.00) RTA CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND**

WHEREAS, the bid of National Industrial & Epoxy Coatings Corporation located at 4910 East 345th Street, Willoughby, Ohio 44905 for the furnishing of repairs to the spalled floor and correction of the drainage problem at the Service Building was received on June 8, 1992 for a price set forth in said bid of sixty-three thousand two hundred forty & 00/100 dollars (\$63,240.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of National Industrial & Epoxy Coatings Corporation to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of National Industrial & Epoxy Coatings Corporation received on June 8, 1992 be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.


Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with National Industrial & Epoxy Coatings Corporation for repairs to the spalled floor and correction of the drainage problem at the Service Building.


Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of RTA Capital Improvement Fund in the amount not to exceed sixty-three thousand two hundred forty & 00/100 dollars (\$63,240.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent for future contract years upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
