

RESOLUTION NO. 1992-108

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH SCHIRMER CONSTRUCTION COMPANY
FOR PROJECT 4.18 - EMERGENCY REPAIR OF E. 121ST STREET
AND MARTIN LUTHER KING DRIVE BRIDGES (EST. \$146,562.11 -
RTA CAPITAL FUND)

WHEREAS, the bid of Schirmer Construction Company located at 4197
W. 150th Street, Cleveland, Ohio 44135, for Project 4.18 to perform emergency
repairs on the E. 121st Street and Martin Luther King Drive Bridges was opened on
the 14th day of July 1992; and

WHEREAS, Schirmer Construction Company submitted a bid to provide the
emergency repair services to the E. 121st Street and Martin Luther King Drive
Bridges at a price of one hundred forty-six thousand five hundred sixty-two &
11/100 dollars (\$146,562.11); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Schirmer Construction
Company to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends
acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater
Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Schirmer Construction Company received on
July 14, 1992 be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid
from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is
hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Schirmer Construction Company for
emergency repairs to the E. 121st Street and Martin Luther King Drive Bridges.

Section 3. The said contract shall be payable out of the RTA Capital
Fund, Object Class 105000 in an amount not to exceed one hundred forty-six
thousand five hundred sixty-two & 11/100 dollars (\$146,562.11).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation
of the Authority contingent upon appropriations for future contract years and
upon compliance by the contractor to the bid Specification and Addenda, if any;
the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution
1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to
the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately
upon its adoption.
