

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH OHIO MATERIALS HANDLING, INC. FOR THE FURNISHING OF ONE (1) 6,000 LB. CAPACITY GASOLINE POWERED HEAVY DUTY FORK-LIFT, AS SPECIFIED FOR AN EXPENDITURE OF \$27,370.00 (RTA CAPITAL FUND, NORTH OLMSTED BUDGET).

WHEREAS, the bid of Ohio Materials Handling, Inc. located at 7100 Krick Road, Bedford, Ohio 44146, for the furnishing of one (1) 6,000 lb. capacity gasoline powered heavy duty fork-lift, as specified was received on the 23rd day of July, 1992, for the price set forth in said bid, involving an expenditure of twenty-seven thousand three hundred seventy & 00/100 dollars (\$27,370.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Ohio Materials Handling, Inc. to be the lowest responsible bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Ohio Materials Handling, Inc. for the furnishing of one (1) 6,000 lb. capacity gasoline powered heavy duty fork-lift, as specified, be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

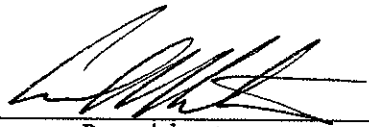
Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Ohio Materials Handling, Inc. for the furnishing of one (1) 6,000 lb. capacity gasoline powered heavy duty fork-lift, as specified.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the RTA Capital Fund (North Olmsted Budget), in an amount not to exceed twenty-seven thousand three hundred seventy & 00/100 dollars (\$27,370.00).


Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87 bonding and insurance requirements and applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
