

RESOLUTION 1992- 144

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH VALLEY FORD TRUCK SALES, INC. FOR THE FURNISHING OF DESICCANT KITS AND REBUILT BUS AIR COMPRESSORS, AS SPECIFIED AND AS REQUIRED, FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR FOR AN ESTIMATED EXPENDITURE OF \$105,337.75 (GENERAL FUND, INVENTORY DEPARTMENT BUDGET).

WHEREAS, the bid of Valley Ford Truck Sales, Inc. located at 5715 Canal Rd., Cleveland, Ohio 44125 for the furnishing of desiccant kits and rebuilt bus air compressors, as specified and as required, was received on the 7th day of July 1992, for the price set forth in said bid involving an estimated expenditure of one hundred five thousand three hundred thirty-seven & 75/100 dollars (\$105,337.75); and

WHEREAS, this procurement is divisible;

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Valley Ford Truck Sales, Inc. for Items 2 (GCRTA No. 86-12320-Bendix), 3 (GCRTA No. 86-28320-Bendix), 4 (GCRTA No. 86-29320-Bendix), 5 (GCRTA No. 86-28000-Bendix), 6 (GCRTA No. 86-13000-Bendix) and 7 (GCRTA No. 86-31000-Bendix) of IFB No. 92066 to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Valley Ford Truck Sales, Inc. for Item Nos. 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 of IFB No. 92066 be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Valley Ford Truck Sales, Inc., for the furnishing of desiccant kits and rebuilt bus air compressors, as specified and as required for a period of one (1) year.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund (Inventory Department Budget) in an estimated amount not to exceed one hundred five thousand three hundred thirty-seven & 75/100 dollars (\$105,337.75).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87 bonding and insurance requirements and applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.


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Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
