

RESOLUTION NO. 1992-145

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH MACRO CORPORATION FOR THE FURNISHING OF ARCHITECTURAL AND ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR PROJECT 12-AG TO DEVELOP A CONSOLIDATED TRAIN DISPATCHING SYSTEM (\$263,340.48) (\$210,672.38 IN FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS 80% OF THE TOTAL PRICE-CAPITAL GRANT OH-03-0062, \$52,668.10 IN RTA LOCAL MATCH AND ODOT FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS 20% OF THE TOTAL PRICE).

WHEREAS, the proposal of Macro Corporation located at 700 Business Center Drive, Horsham, PA 19044-3471 to provide architectural/engineering services for Project 12-AG - Consolidated Train Dispatching System (CTDS) was received on June 12, 1992;

WHEREAS, Macro Corporation submitted an offer to provide architectural/engineering services for Project 12-AG, Consolidated Train Dispatching System, at a price of two hundred sixty three thousand three hundred forty and 48/100 dollars; (\$263,340.48); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems Macro Corporation to be the most qualified provider of the required architectural/engineering services, finds the negotiated price to be reasonable, and therefore recommends the same for acceptance by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the proposal submitted by Macro Corporation on July 12, 1992 be and it is hereby accepted as the most advantageous proposal for architectural/engineering services for Project 12-AG Consolidated Train Dispatching System at a negotiated price of two hundred sixty three thousand, three hundred forty and 48/100 dollars (\$263,340.48)

Section 2. That said contract shall incorporate and be consistent with the proposal of Macro Corporation dated July 12, 1992 as amended by negotiations.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable from Capital Grant OH-03-0062, 80% of said contract (\$210,672.38; and RTA local match and ODOT funds, 20% of said contract (\$52,668.10).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contract to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any, the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this Resolution take effect immediately upon its adoption.
