

RESOLUTION NO. 1992- 150

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH ENGINEERING-SCIENCE FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES, PROJECT 3.00B - HAYDEN GARAGE SOIL REMEDIATION (\$568,497.00 - RTA INSURANCE FUND) - ENGINEERING & CONSTRUCTION DIVISION

WHEREAS, the proposal of Engineering-Science located at 19101 Villaview Road, Suite 301, Cleveland, Ohio 44119 to provide engineering services for Project 3.00B - Hayden Garage Soil Remediation was received on July 17, 1992; and

WHEREAS, Engineering-Science submitted an offer to provide engineering services for Project 3.00B at a price of five hundred sixty eight thousand four hundred ninety seven & 00/100 dollars (\$568,497.00); and

WHEREAS, The General Manager deems the proposal submitted by Engineering-Science to be in the best interest of the Authority to perform the required engineering services, finds the negotiated price to be reasonable, and therefore recommends the same for acceptance by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the proposal submitted by Engineering-Science on July 17, 1992 be and it is hereby accepted as the most advantageous proposal for engineering services for Project 3.00B - Hayden Garage Soil Remediation at a negotiated price of five hundred sixty eight thousand four hundred ninety seven & 00/100 dollars (\$568,497.00).

Section 2. That said contract shall incorporate and be consistent with the proposal of Engineering-Science dated July 17, 1992 as amended by negotiations.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable from the RTA Insurance Fund, in the amount of five hundred sixty eight thousand four hundred ninety seven & 00/100 dollars (\$568,497.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the consultant to the Proposal Specification and Addenda, if any, the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this Resolution take effect immediately upon its adoption.
