

RESOLUTION NO. 1992-170

**AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH PAMIC INTERNATIONAL CORPORATION/GEDCON SALES FOR THE FURNISHING OF SIX (6) CHOPPER BLOWER MOTORS FOR THE BREDA LIGHT RAIL VEHICLES IN THE AMOUNT OF THIRTY-TWO THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE & 66/100 DOLLARS. (\$32,355.66) - OF WHICH 80% (\$25,884.53) IS FEDERALLY FUNDED FROM CAPITAL GRANT OH-90-X166**

WHEREAS, the bid of Pamic International Corporation/Gedcon Sales, located at 23 Progress St. Edison, N.J. 08820, for the furnishing of six (6) chopper blower motors for the Breda light rail vehicles was received on the 9th of October, 1992, for the price set forth in said bid, involving an expenditure of thirty-two thousand three hundred fifty-five & 66/100 dollars (\$32,355.66); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Pamic International Corporation/Gedcon Sales to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Pamic International Corporation/Gedcon Sales be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Pamic International Corporation/Gedcon Sales for the furnishing of six (6) chopper blower motors for the Breda light rail vehicles.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of Capital Grant OH-90-X166 in the amount of thirty-two thousand three hundred fifty-five & 66/100 dollars (\$32,355.66).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon appropriations for future contract years and upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.


Section 5. That this resolution shall be come effective immediately upon its adoption.
