

RESOLUTION NO. 1992- 178

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH MCPHILLIPS PLUMBING, HEATING & A/C COMPANY FOR HEATING & VENTILATING REPAIRS AT HAYDEN GARAGE, PROJECT 17BI (\$25,790.00 - RTA CAPITAL FUND) - ENGINEERING & CONSTRUCTION DIVISION

WHEREAS, the bid of McPhillips Plumbing, Heating & A/C Company located at 16115 Waterloo Road, Cleveland, Ohio 44110 for heating and ventilating repairs at Hayden Garage was received on the 16th day of October 1992 for the price set forth in said bid, involving an expenditure of twenty-five thousand seven hundred ninety & 00/100 dollars (\$25,790.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of McPhillips Plumbing, Heating & A/C Company to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of McPhillips Plumbing, Heating & A/C Company for heating and ventilating repairs at Hayden Garage be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with McPhillips Plumbing, Heating & A/C Company for heating and ventilating repairs at Hayden Garage.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the RTA Capital Fund, in the amount of twenty-five thousand seven hundred ninety & 00/100 dollars (\$25,790.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the bid Specifications and Addenda, if any, the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this Resolution take effect immediately upon its adoption.
