

RESOLUTION NO. 1992-179

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH SEITZ BUILDERS, INC., FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF COMMUNICATION AND STORAGE ROOMS AT TOWER CITY (PROJECT 12AE1) \$69,300.00 - CAPITAL GRANT OH-03-0113, \$31,878.00; \$37,422.00, RTA CAPITAL FUND (\$23,908.50 IN FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENT 34.5% OF THE TOTAL PROJECT COST)

WHEREAS, the bid of Seitz Builders, Inc. located at 8055 Broadview Road, Broadview Heights, Ohio 44147 for the construction of Project 12AE1 - Communication and Storage Rooms at Tower City was received on October 12, 1992 for the price set forth in said bid of sixty-nine thousand three hundred & 00/100 dollars (\$69,300.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Seitz Builders, Inc., to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Seitz Builders, Inc., received on October 12, 1992 be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Seitz Builders, Inc., for the construction of Project 12AE1 - Communication and Storage Rooms at Tower City.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the RTA Capital Fund, in the amount not to exceed thirty-seven thousand four hundred twenty-two & 00/100 dollars (37,422.00) and Capital Grant OH-03-0113 in the amount of thirty-one thousand eight hundred seventy-eight & 00/100 dollars (\$31,878.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent for future contract years upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
