

RESOLUTION NO. 1992-190

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH HEWETT COMPANY, INCORPORATED FOR THE FURNISHING OF SITE PREPARATION, FABRICATION, AND INSTALLATION OF BUS PASSENGER SHELTERS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$548,775.00 - CAPITAL GRANTS OH-05-0025 \$296,332.50 AND OH-90-X166 \$252,442.50 (\$439,020.00 IN FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS 80% OF THE TOTAL

WHEREAS, the bid of Hewett Company Incorporated located at 210 Orchard Lake Road, Pontiac, Michigan 48341 for the furnishing of site preparation, fabrication and installation of bus passenger shelters was received on October 6, 1992 for the price set forth in said bid of five hundred forty eight thousand seven hundred seventy five & 00/100 dollars (\$548,775.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Hewett Company Incorporated to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Hewett Company Incorporated received on October 6, 1992 be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Hewett Company Incorporated for the furnishing of site preparation, fabrication, and installation of bus passenger shelters.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the RTA Capital Fund in the amount not to exceed four hundred thirty nine thousand twenty & 00/100 dollars (439,020.00) and Capital Grants OH-05-0025 in the amount of two hundred ninety six thousand three hundred thirty two & 50/100 dollars (\$296,332.50) and OH-90-X166 in the amount of two hundred fifty two thousand four hundred forty two & 50/100 dollars (\$252,442.50).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent for future contract years upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
