

RESOLUTION NO. 1992-193

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH URS CONSULTANTS, FOR THE FURNISHING OF FINAL DESIGN AND ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR PROJECT 082 - GATEWAY PASSENGER ACCESSWAY PROJECT (\$300,000.00) (\$267,000.00 IN FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS 89% OF THE TOTAL PRICE, CAPITAL GRANT OH-90-X170 - \$33,000.00 IN RTA LOCAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS 11% OF THE TOTAL PRICE)

WHEREAS, the proposal of URS Consultants located at 3605 Warrensville Center Road, Cleveland, Ohio 44122-5203 to provide final design and architectural/engineering services for RTA Gateway Passenger Accessway was received on September 9, 1992; and

WHEREAS, URS Consultants submitted an offer to provide architectural/engineering services for Project 082, RTA Gateway Passenger Accessway at a price of three hundred thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$300,000.00); and

WHEREAS, The General Manager deems URS Consultants to be the most qualified provider of the required architectural/engineering services, finds the negotiated price to be reasonable, and therefore recommends the same for acceptance by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the proposal submitted by URS Consultants on September 9, 1992 be and it is hereby accepted as the most advantageous proposal for architectural/engineering services for Project 082, Final Design and Engineering Services for Gateway Passenger Accessway at a negotiated price of three hundred thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$300,000.00).

Section 2. That said contract shall incorporate and be consistent with the proposal of URS Consultants dated September 9, 1992 as amended by negotiations.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable from Capital Grant OH-90-X170, 89% of said contract (\$267,000.00); and RTA local match funds, 11% of said contract (\$33,000.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contract to the Proposal Scope of Services and Addenda, if any, the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this Resolution take effect immediately upon its adoption.
