

**AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH H.J. SKELTON (CANADA) LTD.
FOR THE FURNISHING OF TWO (2) SLIDING TRAIN STOP
ASSEMBLIES \$53,840.00 - CAPITAL GRANT: OH-90-0019,
\$53,840.00; (\$43,072.00 IN FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS
80% OF THE TOTAL COST).**

WHEREAS, the bid of H.J. Skelton (Canada) LTD. located at 165 Oxford Street, E. London, Ontario, Canada for the furnishing of two (2) sliding train stop assemblies was received on the 22nd of October, 1992 for the price set forth in said bid, involving an expenditure of fifty-three thousand eight hundred forty & 00/100 dollars (\$53,840.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of H.J. Skelton (Canada) LTD. to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of H.J. Skelton (Canada) LTD. for the furnishing of two (2) sliding train stop assemblies be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with H.J. Skelton (Canada) LTD. for the furnishing of two (2) sliding train stop assemblies.


Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of Capital Grant OH-90-0019 in the amount of fifty-three thousand eight hundred forty & 00/100 dollars (\$53,840.00).

Section 4. That said contract is subject to Federal Transit Administration (FTA) approval of a waiver of the Buy America requirement.

Section 5. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan Adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
