RESOLUTION NO. 1992 - 242

A RESOLUTION TO MAKE AMENDED APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE GREATER CLEVELAND REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY DURING 1992 AND TO AMEND RESOLUTION NOS. 1991-258 AND 1992-161.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That no transfers of funds be made in this Appropriation Budget from one department to another without approval of the Board of Trustees. That transfers made within a department from one line item to another be reported to the Board within thirty days after the end of the month in which said transfer occurred.

Section 2. That the appropriation for the current expenses and other expenditures of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority during the period January 1, 1992 through December 31, 1992, made by Resolution 1991-258 and amended by Resolution 1992-161, is hereby amended to read as attached in order that the amounts appropriated to each classification shall be not less than the amounts expended or encumbered in each classification during the fiscal year for which such appropriations are made and are hereby set aside and appropriated.

Section 3. That the 1992 Annual Budget Appropriation be amended to read as per the attached pages which are incorporated herein by reference and made a part of this resolution as if set forth in their entirety.

Section 4. That the Annual Budget Appropriation as amended provides funding for the twenty-seventh bi-weekly pay period and authorizes payment of said wages in calendar year 1992 for all employees, including salaried employees. This appropriation was made in the original 1992 budget as adopted in December 1991.

Section 5. That the Annual Budget Appropriation as amended provides funds for a pay adjustment averaging three percent (3%) for salaried employees in pay ranges seven through twenty-one, and that such adjustments be based upon the 1991 Merit Pay Matrix and effective with the pay period beginning September 28, 1992.

Proposed Budget Revisions 1992 Budget

The following highlights the proposed appropriation adjustments to the 1992 Budget. The total General Fund appropriation level includes funding for the new ATU contract, as well as a retroactive pay increase to September 28, 1992 for the non-represented employees in grades 7 thru 21. The following narrative is provided for all other significant budget adjustments.

GENERAL FUND

OPERATIONS DIVISION

DEPT. #36 - POWER

ADDITION = \$ 65,709

Funds are needed to cover the payment of the December 1991 rail propulsion invoice which was paid out of 1992 budget dollars. This problem is offset by a favorable trend in expenditures for materials and supplies.

DEPT. #37 - FACILITIES MAINTENANCE

REDUCTION = (\$159.881)

Funds are available in Authority-wide utilities due to the energy management task force efforts.

DEPT. #40 - BUS EQUIPMENT

ADDITION = \$33.001

Funds needed to cover the new ATU contract (\$381,000) is offset by favorable variances in materials and supplies (\$125,000) and fuel (\$175,000).

DEPT. #41 - RAIL EQUIPMENT

REDUCTION = (\$ 91,779)

Funds are available due to delays in awarding the electric motor repair contract. The contract will be rebid and awarded in February of 1993 at the earliest.

DEPT. #43 - SATELLITES AND PASS THRUS

REDUCTION = (\$ 90,491)

Funds are available from the 1991 encumbrance rollover for North Olmsted and Maple Heights; diesel fuel prices have been less than budgeted.

Proposed Budget Revisions 1992 Budget Page 2

DEPT. #45 - PARATRANSIT EQUIPMENT

REDUCTION = (\$135, 164)

Favorable variance here is due to fuel prices being less than budgeted, and materials and supplies expenditures under budget.

DEPTS. #46, #47, #48, #49 - BUS DISTRICTS ADDITION = \$1,243,492

Additional funds are needed for operators labor and related fringes, mostly due to the retroactive pay.

MARKETING & DEVELOPMENT DIVISION

DEPT. #54 - OPERATIONS PLANNING

REDUCTION = (\$108,189)

Funds are available due to vacant positions and lower than budgeted estimates for outside services.

DEPT. #55 - STRATEGIC PLANNING & RESEARCH REDUCTION = (\$ 88,456)

Funds are available due to vacant positions and lower than anticipated expenses for outside services.

DEPT. #56 - MEDIA RELATIONS

ADDITION = (\$12,944)

Funds transferred to Marketing department for outside consultant.

HUMAN RESOURCES DIVISION

DEPT. #14 - PERSONNEL ADMINISTRATION

REDUCTION = (\$73,050)

Funds are available due to vacant positions and a decrease in overtime.

DEPT. #17 - WORKER'S COMPENSATION

ADDITION = \$172,762

Additional funds are required for worker's compensation injuries/damages to employees and worker's compensation medical payments.

DEPT. #30 - TRAINING

REDUCTION = (\$22,409)

Funds are available due to a reduction of various training programs.

OTHER DEPARTMENTS DIVISION

DEPT. #99 - TRANSFERS

REDUCTION = (\$1,000,000)

Contribution to capital has been reduced by \$1 million.

FINANCE DIVISION

DEPT. #62 - SUPPORT SERVICES

ADDITION = \$29,292

Additional funds needed to cover postage expense and copy machine lease agreements.

LEGAL DIVISION

DEPT. #20 - CLAIMS

ADDITION = \$101,465

Additional funds needed to cover an increase in liability and property damage claims.
