

RESOLUTION NO. 1993-4

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH SCHUNK GRAPHITE TECHNOLOGY FOR THE FURNISHING OF 1500 PANTOGRAPH CARBON SHOES, THE ANTICIPATED AUTHORITY USAGE DURING A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR (\$136,425.00 - GENERAL FUND) INVENTORY DEPARTMENT BUDGET

Whereas, the bid of Schunk Graphite, located at W146 N9300 Held Dr., Menomonee Falls, WI 53051, for the furnishing of 1500 pantograph carbon shoes was received on the 7th day of January, 1992, for the price set forth in said bid, involving an expenditure of one hundred thirty-six thousand four hundred twenty-five & 00/100 dollars (\$136,425.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Schunk Graphite Technology to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Schunk Graphite Technology be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest and best responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Schunk Graphite Technology for the furnishing of 1500 pantograph carbon shoes during a period of one (1) year.


Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund (Inventory Department Budget) in an amount not to exceed one hundred thirty-six thousand four hundred twenty-five & 00/100 dollars (\$136,425.00).

Section 4. That said contract is subject to Federal Transit Administration waiver of the Buy America requirements.

Section 5. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon appropriations for future contract years and upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
