

RESOLUTION NO. 1993- 9

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH DON HARVEY FOR THE DESIGN AND INSTALLATION OF ART AT THE W. 25TH STREET RAPID STATION - \$20,710.00, CAPITAL GRANT OH-90-0078 (\$16,568.00 IN FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS 80% OF THE TOTAL COST)

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees by Resolution No. 1991-172 established the Arts-in-Transit program for the purpose of implementing a program to integrate art into various public transit facilities; and

WHEREAS, Don Harvey of 1711 Merwin Street, Cleveland, Ohio 44113 submitted an offer to design and install art for the West 25th Street Rapid Station at a price of twenty thousand seven hundred ten & 00/100 dollars (\$20,710.00); and

WHEREAS, The General Manager deems the proposal of Mr. Don Harvey to be the most advantageous to the Authority at the price negotiated and therefore recommends the same for acceptance by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the proposal submitted by Don Harvey on May 29, 1992 for art design and installation at the W. 25th Street Rapid Station be and are hereby accepted as the most advantageous for the Authority.

Section 2. That said contract shall incorporate and be consistent with the proposal of Don Harvey dated May 29, 1992, as amended by negotiations.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable from Capital Grant OH-90-0078 in the amount of \$20,710.00.

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contract with the scope of services as negotiated and addenda, if any, the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this Resolution take effect immediately upon its adoption.
