RESOLUTION 1993–19

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH COPCO PAPERS INC. FOR THE FURNISHING OF RECYCLED COPY PAPER FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR THROUGH THE STATE OF OHIO COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM (\$32,816.00 - GENERAL FUND, SUPPORT SERVICES DEPARTMENT BUDGET)

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees authorized utilization of The State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program in Resolution 1990-69.

WHEREAS, the Cooperative Purchasing Act provides political subdivisions within the State of Ohio with the opportunity to participate in contracts executed by the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services, Office of State Purchasing, for the purchase of supplies, services, equipment and certain materials; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code, Section 306.44, permits trustees of the regional transit authority to enter into agreements with the state in order to exercise the powers granted by Ohio Revised Code, Section 306.30 to 306.47 inclusive, and

WHEREAS, the General Manager has deemed it to be in the best interest of the Authority to utilize the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program for the purchase of recycled copier paper of a period of one (1) year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager of the Authority is authorized to enter into a contract with COPCO Papers Inc., 5905 Grant, Cleveland, Ohio 44105.

Section 2. That this contract is entered into under the authority granted by the Ohio Revised Code, Section 306.30 and 306.47 inclusive.

Section 3. That this contract shall be for recycled copier paper specified in bid contract 980173-DH of the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program.

Section 4. That said contract be payable out of the General Fund (Support Services Department) Line Item 504.000, Materials and Supplies Consumed, in an amount not to exceed thirty-two thousand eight hundred sixteen & 00/100 dollars (\$32,816.00),

Section 5. That this contract shall be a binding obligation of the Authority.

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Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
