

RESOLUTION NO. 1993- 59

**AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH DIGITAL EQUIPMENT CORPORATION FOR THE FURNISHING OF A DIGITAL PATHWORKS MODEL 3100-90 PC NETWORK FILE SERVER THROUGH THE STATE OF OHIO COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM AT A TOTAL PRICE OF \$49,994.36 - RTA CAPITAL FUND, DATA SYSTEMS DEPARTMENT BUDGET.**

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees by Resolution 1990-69 authorized the utilization of the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program;

WHEREAS, the Cooperative Purchasing Program allows political subdivisions within the State of Ohio to purchase equipment through the Department of Administrative Services;

WHEREAS, the Department of Administrative Services has awarded a contract to Digital Equipment Corporation for the furnishing of computer hardware;

WHEREAS, the Digital Pathworks Model 3100-90 PC Network File Server furnished at a price of forty-nine thousand nine hundred ninety-four & 36/100 dollars (\$49,994.36) is in accordance with this Department of Administrative Services contract; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager has deemed it to be in the best interest of the Authority to utilize the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program for the purchase of this computer hardware.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Digital Equipment Corporation whose local office is a Lake Point Office Park, 3201 Enterprise Parkway Drive, Beachwood, Ohio 44122 for the furnishing of Digital Pathworks Model 3100-90 PC Network File Server for a total price of (forty-nine thousand nine hundred ninety-four & 36/100 dollars (\$49,994.36), priced in accordance with the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services Contract No. 3113500.

Section 2. That said contract shall be payable out of the RTA Capital Fund in the amount of forty-nine thousand hundred ninety-four & 36/100 dollars (\$49,994.36).

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon the compliance by the contractor to the Specifications and addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements, and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
