AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH UNIVERSAL COACH PARTS, INCORPORATED FOR THE FURNISHING OF NIEHOFF GENERATOR REPLACEMENT PARTS ON AN AS REQUIRED BASIS FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR (EST. \$98,000.65 - GENERAL FUND) - INVENTORY DEPARTMENT BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the bid of Universal Coach Parts, Incorporated, located at 105 East Oakton, Des Plaines, Illinois 60018, for the furnishing of Niehoff generator replacements parts was received on the 2nd of March 1993, for the price set forth in said bid, involving an estimated expenditure of ninety-eight thousand & 65/100 (\$98,000.65) dollars; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Universal Coach Parts, Incorporated to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Universal Coach Parts, Incorporated be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Universal Coach Parts, Incorporated for the of Niehoff generator replacement parts, as required, for a period of one (1) year.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund (Inventory Department budget) in an amount not to exceed ninety-eight thousand & 65/00 (\$98,000.65) dollars.

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon the compliance by the contractor to the Specifications and addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements, and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
