

RESOLUTION NO. 1993-66

A RESOLUTION RESCINDING RESOLUTION 1992-220 AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH JACK MAXTON CHEVROLET FOR THE FURNISHING OF TWO (2) FOUR DOOR UTILITY TYPE POLICE VEHICLES PURCHASED THROUGH THE STATE OF OHIO COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM AT THE PRICE OF \$48,256.00 - CAPITAL GRANT OH 90-X166 (\$38,604.80 IN FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS 80% OF THE TOTAL).

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees by Resolution 1990-69 authorized utilization of The State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 1992-220, the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority authorized a contract with Jack Maxton Chevrolet for the furnishing of two (2) 4-door utility type service vehicles; and

WHEREAS, this award was made improperly, pursuant to notification received from the Ohio State Cooperative Purchasing Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. The Resolution No. 1992-220 be and is hereby rescinded.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby directed to communicate this action to Jack Maxton Chevrolet.

Section 3. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
