

RESOLUTION NO. 1993- 71

AUTHORIZING A CHANGE ORDER TO THE CONTRACT WITH URS CONSULTANTS, INC. FOR THE DESIGN OF THE GCRTA PASSENGER ACCESSWAY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$263,743.00 CAPITAL GRANT OH-90-X170 (\$234,731.27 IN FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS APPROXIMATELY 89% OF THE TOTAL) - ENGINEERING AND CONSTRUCTION DIVISION.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees by Resolution No. 1992-193 authorized a contract with URS Consultants, Inc., for the design and engineering of the GCRTA Passenger Accessway connecting the Tower City Rapid Station to the Gateway Arena and Sports Complex an estimate cost of three hundred thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$300,000.00); and

WHEREAS, additional services are needed; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the additional services is estimated at two hundred sixty three thousand seven hundred forty-three & 00/100 dollars (\$263,743.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager be and he is hereby authorized to modify the contract with URS Consultants, Inc. to include the additional services necessary for the design of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority Passenger Accessway connecting the Tower City Rapid Station to the Gateway Arena and Sports Complex.

Section 2. That the General Manager be and he is hereby authorized to increase the price of the contract with URS Consultants, Inc. by two hundred sixty three thousand seven hundred forty-three & 00/100 dollars (\$263,743.00) to a maximum total price of five hundred sixty three thousand seven hundred forty three & 00/100 dollars (\$563,743.00).

Section 3. That the General Manager's change order authority pursuant to Section I-4.2.7.2 of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority Procurement Policy is reauthorized for this procurement action.


Section 4. That this contract amendment shall be payable out of Capital Grant OH-90-X170, Engineering and Construction budget.

Section 5. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority and contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligation of the Authority.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
