

RESOLUTION NO. 1993- 97

AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT 92112 WITH ATLAS RAILROAD CONSTRUCTION COMPANY TO PROVIDE TRACKWORK TO REHABILITATE THE WESTSIDE PORTION OF THE RED LINE RAPID TRANSIT W. 117TH STREET TO THE AIRPORT BY INCREASING THE SCOPE OF WORK TO INCLUDE ADDITIONAL CROSS TIE MATERIALS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED (\$345,000.00) CAPITAL GRANT OH-03-0104 - (\$258,750.00 IN FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS 75% OF THE TOTAL)

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees by Resolution No. 1992-234 authorized Contract 92112 with Atlas Railroad Construction Company for the provision of construction services for Trackwork to Rehabilitate the Westside portion of the Red Line Rapid Transit W. 117th Street to the Airport which included provisions for the Contractor to supply as overruns up to 25% (2,500 units) of the original quantity of cross ties at no change in unit prices; and

WHEREAS, the Authority's needs have exceeded the 25% limit by an additional 2,000 cross tie units; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager has determined that it is in the best interest of the Authority to facilitate the provision for overruns of up to 25% in cross ties at contract unit prices and to procure from the Contractor an additional 2,000 cross tie units at a negotiated price for a total increase of three hundred forty five thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$345,000.00) to the contract price.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to amend Contract 92112 with Atlas Railroad Construction Company for the provision of additional cross ties in an amount not to exceed three hundred forty five thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$345,000.00).

Section 2. That said amendment shall be payable from Capital Grant OH-03-0104 in an amount not to exceed three hundred forty five thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$345,000.00).

Section 3. That said amendment shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon appropriations for future contract years and upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
