

RESOLUTION NO. 1993-98

AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT 93024 WITH DOMINIC CALABRESE CEMENT CONTRACTORS, INCORPORATED FOR THE REHABILITATION OF BUS LOOPS AT (18D) E. 131ST STREET/MILES AND (18E) E. 159TH STREET/KINSMAN (CHAGRIN BOULEVARD) BY ELIMINATING THE (18E) PORTION OF THE CONTRACT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$196,968.40, CAPITAL GRANT OH-90-X179 (\$157,574.72 IN FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS 80% OF THE TOTAL)

WHEREAS, Resolution 1993-75 authorized Contract 93024 with Dominic Calabrese Cement Contractors, Incorporated for the provision of work for Rehabilitation of Bus Loops at (18D) E. 131st Street/Miles and (18E) E. 159th Street/Kinsman (Chagrin Boulevard) and the needs of the Authority have changed in such a way that the Rehabilitation of the (18E) E. 159th Street/Kinsman (Chagrin Boulevard) portion of the contract is no longer required; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager has determined that it is in the best interest of the Authority to implement a cardinal change in the contract and reduce the scope of work by eliminating the (18E) E. 159th Street/Kinsman (Chagrin Boulevard) portion of the contract, thereby reducing the total contract by a mutually agreed amount of (\$196,968.40) to reflect said reduction in the scope of work.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to amend Contract 93024 with Dominic Calabrese Cement Contractors, Incorporated for the reduction of the (18E) E. 159th Street/Kinsman (Chagrin Boulevard) portion of the scope of work for the contract in a reduced amount not to exceed one hundred ninety six thousand nine hundred sixty eight & 40/100 dollars (\$196,968.40).

Section 2. That amendment to said contract shall be deducted out of Capital Grant OH-90-X179.


Section 3. That amendment to said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon appropriations for future contract years and upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
