

RESOLUTION NO. 1993-101

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH NATIONAL ENGINEERING & CONTRACTING CO, FOR PROJECT 30 - CONSTRUCTION OF GREATER CLEVELAND REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY'S ACCESSWAY TO GATEWAY \$7,745,000.00 CAPITAL GRANT OH-90-X170 (\$7,540,406.00 IN FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENT APPROXIMATELY 97% OF THE TOTAL CONSTRUCTION COST) AND RTA CAPITAL FUND \$204,594.00

WHEREAS, the bid of National Engineering & Contracting Co. located at 12608 Alameda Drive, Strongsville, Ohio 44136 for the construction of the of Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority's Accessway to Gateway was received on June 8, 1993; and

WHEREAS, National Engineering & Contracting Co. submitted an offer to perform the complete construction services for Project 30 - Construction Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority Accessway to Gateway at a cost of seven million seven hundred forty-five thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$7,745,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of National Engineering & Contracting Co. to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of National Engineering & Contracting Co. for the provision of construction services for the construction of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority Accessway to Gateway, be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with National Engineering & Contracting Co. to perform the construction services for Project 30 - Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority Accessway to Gateway.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of Capital Grant OH-90-X170, in the amount of seven million five hundred forty thousand four hundred six & 00/100 dollars (\$7,540,406.00) and out of the RTA Capital Fund in the amount of two hundred four thousand five hundred ninety-four & 00/100 dollars (\$204,594.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority, subject to acquisition of the rights necessary to construct the project, and contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specifications and Addenda, if any, the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88; bonding and insurance requirements; and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this Resolution take effect immediately upon its adoption.
