

RESOLUTION NO. 1993-125

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH SIMON SIGN & MAINTENANCE, INC. FOR THE FABRICATION & INSTALLATION OF SAFETY SIGNAGE & GRAPHICS FOR LOGO SIGNS, PROJECT 10H(II) (\$45,697.00 - RTA CAPITAL FUND) - ENGINEERING & CONSTRUCTION DIVISION.

WHEREAS, the bid of Simon Sign & Maintenance, Inc. located at 6530 Carnegie Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio 44103 for the fabrication and installation of safety signage & graphics for logo signs, Project 10H(II) was received on July 21, 1993 for a price set forth in said bid, involving an expenditure of forty five thousand six hundred ninety seven & 00/100 dollars (\$45,697.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Simon Sign & Maintenance, Inc. to be the lowest bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Simon Sign & Maintenance, Inc. for the fabrication & installation of safety signage & graphics for logo signs, Project 10H(II) be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.


Section 2. That the General Manager be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Simon Sign & Maintenance, Inc. for the fabrication & installation of safety signage & graphics for logo signs, Project 10H(II).

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the RTA Capital Fund in an amount not to exceed forty five thousand six hundred ninety seven & 00/100 dollars (\$45,697.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon appropriations for future contract years and upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
