

RESOLUTION NO. 1993-171

AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT 92112 WITH ATLAS RAILROAD CONSTRUCTION COMPANY TO PROVIDE TRACKWORK TO REHABILITATE THE WESTSIDE PORTION OF THE RED LINE RAPID TRANSIT W. 117TH STREET TO THE AIRPORT BY INCREASING THE SCOPE OF WORK TO INCLUDE BROOKPARK YARD MODIFICATIONS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$150,529.19 CAPITAL GRANT OH-03-0104 (\$112,896.89 IN FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS 75% OF THE TOTAL)

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees by Resolution No. 1992-234 authorized Contract 92112 with Atlas Railroad Construction Company for the provision of construction services for trackwork to rehabilitate the Westside portion of the Red Line Rapid Transit W. 117th Street to the Airport; and

WHEREAS, the Authority's needs have now increased to require engineering design, layout, as built drawings, signal and catenary work that will constitute Brookpark yard modifications; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager has determined that it is in the best interest of the Authority for these modifications to be performed under Contract 92112 at a negotiated price of one hundred fifty thousand five hundred twenty nine & 19/100 dollars (\$150,529.19).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to amend contract 92112 with Atlas Railroad Construction Company for the provision of Brookpark yard modifications in an amount not to exceed one hundred fifty thousand five hundred twenty nine & 19/100 dollars (\$150,529.19), and to increase the total price of Contract 92112 to an amount not to exceed six million nine hundred ninety seven twenty five & 38/100 dollars (\$6,997,025.38).


Section 2. That said amendment shall be payable from Capital Grant OH-03-0104.


Section 3. That said amendment shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.
