AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH COUGHLIN FORD, INC. FOR THE FURNISHING OF FOUR (4) POLICE SPECIAL 4-DOOR SEDANS PURCHASED THROUGH THE STATE OF OHIO COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM AT THE TOTAL PRICE OF \$53,904.00 (\$43,123.20 IN FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS 80% OF THE TOTAL COST). CAPITAL GRANT OH-90-X179.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees by Resolution 1990-69 authorized utilization of The State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS, the Cooperative Purchasing Program allows political subdivisions within the State of Ohio to purchase equipment through the Department of Administrative Services; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Administrative Services has contracted with Coughlin Ford, Inc. for the furnishing of police cars as specified; and

WHEREAS, The General Manager has deemed it to be in the best interest of the Authority to utilize the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program for the purchase of four (4) police special four-door sedans at a total price of fifty-three thousand nine hundred four & 00/100 dollars (\$53,904.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Coughlin Ford, Inc. for the furnishing of four (4) police special four-door sedans for a total price of \$53,904.00 under Department of Administrative Services, Contract No. 180143-I (class, item & spec #040-88-5001).

Section 2. That said contract shall be payable out of Capital Grant 0H-09-X179 in the amount of fifty-three thousand nine hundred four & 00/100 dollars (\$53,904.00).

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to bid Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88; bonding and insurance requirements, and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
