

RESOLUTION NO. 1993-183

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH SIMON SIGN & MAINTENANCE, INC. FOR PROJECT 10AD - GRAPHICS AND SIGNAGE FOR GREATER CLEVELAND REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY'S PASSENGER ACCESSWAY TO GATEWAY \$137,988.00 CAPITAL GRANT OH-90-X170 (FUNDED BY 100% LOCAL MATCH FUNDS)

WHEREAS, the bid of Simon Sign & Maintenance, Inc. located at 6530 Carnegie Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio 44103 for the construction and installation of graphics and signage at the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority's Passenger Accessway to Gateway was received on October 29, 1993; and

WHEREAS, Simon Sign & Maintenance, Inc. submitted an offer to perform the construction and install the signage and graphics for Project 10AD - Graphics and Signage for the GCRTA Passenger Accessway to Gateway at a price of one hundred thirty-seven thousand nine hundred eighty-eight & 00/100 dollars (\$137,988.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Simon Sign & Maintenance, Inc. to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Simon Sign & Maintenance, Inc. for the provision of construction graphics and installation services for the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority Accessway to Gateway, be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. that the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Simon Sign & Maintenance, Inc. to provide the construction graphics and installation services for Project 10AD - Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority Accessway to Gateway.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of Local Match Funds in the amount of one hundred thirty-seven thousand nine hundred eighty-eight & 00/100 dollars (\$137,988.00).


Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority, subject to acquisition of the rights necessary to construct the project, and contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specifications and Addenda, if any, the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this Resolution take effect immediately upon its adoption.
