

RESOLUTION NO. 1993-185

AUTHORIZING THE GENERAL MANAGER TO REIMBURSE THE METROPOLITAN LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY FOR ONE-THIRD OF THE COST OF PAVING AN AREA FOR A BUS TURNAROUND AND LAYOVER AT EUCLID SQUARE MALL IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$30,000 - GENERAL FUND

WHEREAS, the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority wishes to provide transit service directly to Euclid Square Mall, and;

WHEREAS, The Metropolitan Life Insurance Company (The Met) manages the Euclid Square Mall, and;

WHEREAS, Kaufmann's owns the land where these buses will be operating, and;

WHEREAS, these parties have agreed to contribute one-third of the cost of paving a bus turnaround;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager is hereby authorized to reimburse The Metropolitan Life Insurance Company for one-third of the cost of paving an area for a bus turnaround and layover at Euclid Square Mall in an amount not to exceed \$30,000, and;

Section 2. That the funds for this expenditure shall be taken from the General Fund, and;

Section 3. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
