

RESOLUTION NO. 1993-192

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH ABC PIPING COMPANY FOR THE TRISKETT LAKEWOOD HEIGHTS ENTRANCE ROADWAY WIDENING, PROJECT 4.66 (\$97,864.00 - RTA CAPITAL FUND) - ENGINEERING AND CONSTRUCTION DIVISION.

WHEREAS, the bid of ABC Piping Company located at 1277 E. Schaaff Road, Brooklyn, Ohio 44131 for the Triskett Lakewood Heights entrance roadway widening was received on the 7th day of December 1993 for the price set forth in said bid, involving an expenditure of ninety seven thousand eight hundred sixty-four & 00/100 dollars (\$97,864.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of ABC Piping Company to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of ABC Piping Company for the Triskett Lakewood Heights entrance roadway widening be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.


Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with ABC Piping Company for the Triskett Lakewood Heights entrance roadway widening.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the RTA Capital Fund, in the amount of ninety seven thousand eight hundred sixty-four & 00/100 dollars (\$97,864.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specifications and Addenda, if any, the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
