

RESOLUTION NO. 1993-205

AUTHORIZING CONTRACTS WITH VARIOUS INDIVIDUALS AND COMPANIES FOR THE SALE OF EIGHT (8) SCRAP VEHICLES - R106, C74, 984, 964, 971, 970, P179, AND R102, IN AN "AS IS" CONDITION FOR A TOTAL PURCHASE PRICE OF FOUR THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED SIXTEEN & 00/100 DOLLARS (\$4,516.00). *

WHEREAS, vehicles numbered R106, C74, 984, 964, 971, 970, P179, and R102 have been determined to be obsolete in accordance with Authority's vehicle replacement policy; and

WHEREAS, the bids of various individuals and companies as listed below for said vehicles were received on the 24th day of November, 1993, for a total price of four thousand five hundred sixteen & 00/100 dollars (\$4,516.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bids of herein named individuals and companies to be the highest responsive bids from responsible bidders and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Ted Pompei, whose address is 4386 W. 226th Street, Fairview Park, Ohio 44126 for the purchase of vehicles numbered R106, 984, P179 and R102 for a total purchase price of five hundred fifteen & 00/100 dollars (\$515.00) be and the same is hereby accepted as the highest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the bid of Hamamey Inc. dba Southwest Cab located at 8700 Akins Road, North Royalton, Ohio 44133, for the purchase of vehicles numbered 964, 971, and 970 for a total purchase price of three thousand seven hundred & 00/100 dollars (\$3,700.00) be and the same is hereby accepted as the highest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 3. That the bid of Edward R. Slupski whose address is 4393 W. 189th Street, Cleveland, Ohio 44135, for the purchase of vehicle number C74 for a total purchase price of three hundred one & 00/100 dollars (\$301.00) be and the same is hereby accepted as the highest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 4. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into contracts with the above listed individuals and companies for the sale of said vehicles as described on such terms as are appropriate for the protection of the interest of the Authority.

Section 5. That the proceeds of said sale in the amount of four thousand five hundred sixteen & 00/100 dollars (\$4,516.00) be deposited into the General Fund.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
