

RESOLUTION NO. 1993-206

**AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH VARIOUS INDIVIDUALS AND COMPANIES FOR THE SALE OF EIGHT (8) SCRAP VEHICLES - R132, R104, P144, R103, E82, MT5, E80, AND 01507, IN AN "AS IS" CONDITION FOR A TOTAL PURCHASE PRICE OF TWO THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE & 00/100 DOLLARS (\$2,445.00).**

WHEREAS, vehicles number R132, R104, P144, R103, E82, MT5, E80, and 01507, have been determined to be obsolete in accordance with Authority's vehicle replacement policy; and

WHEREAS, the bids of various individuals and companies as listed below for said vehicles were received on the 6th day of December, 1992, for a total price of two thousand four hundred forty-five & 00/100 dollars (\$2,445.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bids of herein named individuals and companies to be the highest responsive bids from responsible bidders and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Ronald Baron dba Brookpark Landscaping, Inc. located at 1231 W. Bagley Road, Berea, Ohio 44017 for the purchase of Hough loader numbered 01507 for a total purchase price of one thousand six & 00/100 dollars (\$1,006.00) be and the same is hereby accepted as the highest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the bid of Edward R. Slupski whose address is 4393 W. 189th Street, Cleveland, Ohio 44135 for the purchase of vehicles numbered R104, P144, and R103, for a total purchase price of four hundred fifty-three & 00/100 dollars (\$453.00) be and the same is hereby accepted as the highest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 3. That the bid of Ted Pompei whose address is 4386 W. 226th Street, Fairview Park, Ohio 44126, for the purchase of vehicles numbered R132, E82, MT5, and E80 for a total purchase price of nine hundred eighty-six & 00/100 dollars (\$986.00) be and the same is hereby accepted as the highest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 4. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into contracts with the above listed individuals and companies for the sale of said vehicles as described on such terms as are appropriate for the protection of the interest of the Authority.

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Section 5. That the proceeds of said sale in the amount of two thousand four hundred forty-five & 00/100 dollars (\$2,445.00) be deposited into the General Fund.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
