AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT OF CONTRACT 91139 WITH ENGINEERING-SCIENCE TO PROVIDE CONSULTING SERVICES FOR THE CORRECTION OF PHYSICAL DAMAGE AT TRISKETT GARAGE (RTA CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND - EST. \$24,600.00) - HEALTH & SAFETY DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority by Resolution No. 1991-228, authorized Contract 91139 with Engineering-Science to provide consulting services for the correction of physical damage resulting from a fuel leak at the Triskett Garage at a price not to exceed eighty-one thousand forty & 00/100 dollars (\$81,040.00);

WHEREAS, actions by the the Board of Trustees and the General Manager increased the not-to-exceed amount of said contract to two hundred thirty thousand three hundred ninety & 00/100 dollars (\$230,390.00); and

WHEREAS, additional services are required to remediate the site to standards set by regulatory agencies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager be and he is hereby authorized to amend the contract with Engineering-Science to provide consulting services to increase the contract price by an amount not to exceed twenty-four thousand six hundred & 00/100 dollars (\$24,600.00), resulting in a total contract amount not to exceed two hundred fifty-four thousand nine hundred ninety & 00/100 dollars (\$254,990.00).

Section 2. That this amendment shall be be payable out of the RTA Capital Improvement Fund.

Section 3. That all other conditions and provisions of the contract shall remain unchanged.

Section 4. That the General Manager's Change Order authority, pursuant to Section I-4.2.7.2 of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority Procurement Policy, is reauthorized.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
