

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH PARSONS, BRINCKERHOFF QUADE & DOUGLAS, INC., FOR PROJECT 093 - ARCHITECTURAL AND ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR PRELIMINARY ENGINEERING OF THE WATERFRONT TRANSIT LINE (\$1,200,000.00 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND - 100% LOCAL)

WHEREAS, the proposal of Parsons, Brinckerhoff, Quade & Douglas, Inc. (Parsons) located at 55 Frantz Road, Suite 115, Columbus, Ohio 43107 for Project 093 - Architectural & Engineering Services for Preliminary Engineering of the Waterfront Transit Line was received on the 11th day of November 1993; and

WHEREAS, Parsons has submitted an offer to perform the architectural and engineering services necessary to provide the preliminary engineering services for the Authority's Waterfront Transit Line project at a price not to exceed one million two hundred thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$1,200,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems Parsons to be the most qualified provider of the required architectural and engineering services and deems a final negotiated price, not-to-exceed one million two hundred thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$1,200,000.00), to be reasonable and therefore recommends the same for acceptance by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the proposal submitted by Parsons, Brinckerhoff, Quade & Douglas, Inc. on November 11, 1993 be and it is hereby accepted as the most advantageous proposal for architectural/engineering services for Preliminary Engineering of the Waterfront Transit Line.

Section 2. That the General Manager be and he is authorized to enter into a contract with Parsons, Brinckerhoff, Quade & Douglas for architectural and engineering services for the preliminary engineering of the waterfront, subject to final negotiations, at a price not to exceed one million two hundred thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$1,200,000.00)

Section 3. That said contract shall incorporate and be consistent with the proposal of Parsons, Brinckerhoff, Quade & Douglas dated November 11, 1993, as amended by negotiations.

Section 4. That said contract shall be from the GCRTA Capital Improvement Fund - 100% local funds (\$1,200,000.00).

Section 5. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority, subject to acquisition of the rights necessary to construct the project, and contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specifications and Addenda, if any, the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88; bonding and insurance requirements; and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this Resolution take effect immediately upon its adoption.
