

RESOLUTION NO. 1994- 4

AUTHORIZING A CHANGE ORDER TO BOB ROSS GMC FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE 4 X 4 K2500 SUBURBAN IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,648.75 FOR A TOTAL EXPENDITURE OF \$27,599.75 - CAPITAL GRANT OH-90-X166 (\$2,119.00 IN FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS 80% OF THE TOTAL INCREASE).

WHEREAS, the General Manager authorized the small purchase of one 4 X 4 K2500 suburban vehicle for the transit police department from Bob Ross GMC, 85 Loop Road Centerville, Ohio, for \$24,911.00 through the State Cooperative Purchasing Program.

WHEREAS, the transit police require that specialized police equipment be provided with the vehicle.

WHEREAS, the addition of the equipment increases the total expenditure for this vehicle to more than \$25,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager be Inc. be and he is hereby authorized to increase the contracted to Bob Ross GMC by \$2,648.75 for police equipment as specified for a total expenditure of \$27,559.75.


Section 2. That said contract increase be payable out of Capital Grant OH-90-X166 in the amount of \$2,648.75.

Section 3. That said contract modification be consistent with the terms and conditions of the original purchase.


Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specifications and Addenda, if any, the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
