

RESOLUTION NO. 1994-15

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH ENGLEFIELD OIL CO. FOR THE FURNISHING OF ANTI-FREEZE FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR THROUGH THE STATE OF OHIO COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM (IN AN AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED \$35,508.00 - GENERAL FUND) INVENTORY DEPARTMENT BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees authorized utilization of The State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program in Resolution 1990-69.

WHEREAS, the Cooperative Purchasing Act provides political subdivisions within the State of Ohio with the opportunity to participate in contracts executed by the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services, Office of State Purchasing, for the purchase of supplies, services, equipment and certain materials; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code, Section 306.43 (H)(4), permits trustees of a regional transit authority to enter into agreements with the state; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager has deemed it to be in the best interest of the Authority to utilize the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program for the purchase of anti-freeze for a period of one (1) year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager of the Authority is authorized to enter into a contract with Englefield Oil Co., 447 James Parkway, Newark, Ohio 43055.

Section 2. That this contract is entered into under the authority granted by the Ohio Revised Code, Section 306.43 (H)(4).

Section 3. That this contract shall be for anti-freeze specified in bid contract 980158-I of the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program.


Section 4. That said contract be payable out of the General Fund (Inventory Department) Line Item 103.000, Materials and Supplies Inventory in an amount not to exceed thirty-five thousand five hundred eight & 00/100 dollars (\$35,508.00).

Section 5. That this contract shall be a binding obligation of the Authority.


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Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
