

RESOLUTION NO. 1994-16

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH NATIONAL PAPER & PACKAGING COMPANY FOR THE FURNISHING OF PAPER PRODUCTS, AS SPECIFIED AND AS REQUIRED, FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR FOR AN ESTIMATED EXPENDITURE OF \$34,653.00 (GENERAL FUND, INVENTORY DEPARTMENT BUDGET).

WHEREAS, the bid of National Paper & Packaging Company located at 1240 East 55th Street, Cleveland, Ohio 44103 for the furnishing of paper products, as required was received on the 14th day of January 1994, for the price set forth in said bid involving an estimated expenditure of thirty-four thousand six hundred fifty-three & 00/100 dollars (\$34,653.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of National Paper & Packaging Company to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of National Paper & Packaging Company for the furnishing of paper products, as required be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.


Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with National Paper & Packaging Company for the furnishing of paper products, as required, for a period of one (1) year.


Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund (Inventory Department Budget) in an estimated amount not to exceed thirty-four thousand six hundred fifty-three & 00/100 dollars (\$34,653.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
