

RESOLUTION NO. 1994-66

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH ATLAS RAILROAD CONSTRUCTION COMPANY FOR THE SHAKER CROSSINGS REHABILITATION, PROJECT 4.99 AT A PRICE OF \$359,730.00, CAPITAL GRANT OH-03-0128 (\$287,784.00 IN FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS 80% OF THE TOTAL COST OF THE PROJECT).

WHEREAS, the bid of Atlas Railroad Construction Company located at P.O. Box 8/Route 519, Eighty-Four, Pennsylvania, 15330 for the rehabilitation of the Shaker crossings, Project 4.99 was received on March 23, 1994 for the price set forth in said bid, involving an expenditure of three hundred fifty-nine thousand seven hundred thirty & 00/100 dollars (\$359,730.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Atlas Railroad Construction Company to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Atlas Railroad Construction Company for the rehabilitation of the Shaker crossings, Project 4.99 be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.


Section 2. That the General Manager be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Atlas Railroad Construction Company for the rehabilitation of the Shaker crossings, Project 4.99.


Section 3. That said contract shall be payable from Capital Grant OH-03-0128, 80% of said contract (\$287,784.00); and RTA local match funds, 20% of said contract (\$71,946.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specifications and Addenda, if any, the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this Resolution take effect immediately upon its adoption.
