

RESOLUTION NO. 1994-114

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH NEW JERSEY TRANSIT FOR THE INTERAGENCY SALE OF THE MISCELLANEOUS PCC FLEET SPARE PARTS INVENTORY IN "AS IS" CONDITION FOR A TOTAL PRICE OF \$11,000.00.

WHEREAS, the fleet of PCC cars are no longer operated by the Authority in revenue service, and the majority of this fleet has been scrapped and

WHEREAS, these obsolete spare parts are no longer needed and have no value to this Authority; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code, section 306.43(F) does not require competitive bidding when the sale to another public agency, public transit system or regional transit authority is of capital equipment unique to the operation of a public transit system; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the interagency sale of these obsolete PCC fleet spare parts to be in the best interest of the Authority and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the offer of the New Jersey Transit be and the same is hereby accepted.


Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with New Jersey Transit for the interagency sale of obsolete PCC fleet spare parts.

Section 3. That the proceeds of this sale (\$11,000.00) shall be deposited into the General Fund.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
