

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH THE GREAT LAKES CONSTRUCTION CO. FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE CONRAIL CROSSINGS BRIDGE FOUNDATIONS, WATERFRONT TRANSIT LINE, PROJECT 32A (\$1,177,817.40 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND - 100% LOCAL).

WHEREAS, the bid of The Great Lakes Construction Co. located at 6600 Schaaf Road, Cleveland, Ohio 44131 for the construction of the Conrail Crossings Bridge Foundations, Waterfront Line, Project 32A was received on August 11, 1994 for the price set forth in said bid, involving an expenditure of one million one hundred seventy-seven thousand eight hundred seventeen & 40/100 dollars (\$1,177,817.40); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of The Great Lakes Construction Co. to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of The Great Lakes Construction Co. for the construction of the Conrail Crossings Bridge Foundations, Waterfront Line, Project 32A be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.


Section 2. That the General Manager be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with The Great Lakes Construction Co. for the construction of the Conrail Crossings Bridge Foundations, Waterfront Line, Project 32A.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable from GCRTA Capital Improvement Fund - 100% Local funds in an amount not to exceed one million one hundred seventy-seven thousand eight hundred seventeen & 40/100 dollars (\$1,177,817.40).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specifications and Addenda, if any, the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this Resolution take effect immediately upon its adoption.
