## **RESOLUTION NO. 1994-141**

AUTHORIZING A CHANGE ORDER TO CONTRACT NO. 93035 WITH NATIONAL ENGINEERING AND CONTRACTING COMPANY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE GCRTA PASSENGER ACCESSWAY TO GATE—WAY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$145,866.00 CAPITAL GRANT OH-90-X170 (100% LOCAL MATCH)

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees, by Resolution No. 1993-101 authorized a contract with National Engineering and Contracting Co. for the construction of the GCRTA Passenger Accessway connecting the Tower City Rapid Station to the Gateway Arena and Sports Complex at a cost of seven million seven hundred forty-five thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$7,745,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees by Resolutions, 1993-170, 1994-8, 1994-47, and 1994-85 authorized additional construction services to accommodate unforeseen site conditions, revised regulatory and zoning requirements and directed changes in order to ensure that the Passenger Accessway construction project would remain on schedule; and

WHEREAS, directed changes, municipal requirements, and changed security and safety requirements were instituted in the final construction phases of the GCRTA Passenger Accessway; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the additional services is one hundred forty-three thousand eight hundred seventy-six & 00/100 dollars (\$145,866.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. The General Manager be and he is hereby authorized increase the contract with National Engineering & Contracting Company by one hundred forty-five thousand eight hundred sixty-six and 00/100 dollars (\$145,866.00) to a maximum total price of ten million seventy-one thousand five hundred thirty-eight & 00/100 (\$10,071,538.00).

Section 2. That the General Manager's change order authority, pursuant to Section I-4.2.7.2 of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority Procurement Policy, is reauthorized.

Section 3. That this contract amendment shall be payable 100% of GCRTA Local Match Funds.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
