

RESOLUTION NO. 1994- 147

**AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH SCHIRMER CONSTRUCTION COMPANY
FOR PROJECT 24D2 - GENERAL TRADES CONSTRUCTION SERVICES
FOR THE RENOVATION OF WEST PARK RAPID STATION
\$3,359,000.00 CAPITAL GRANT OH-03-0104 (\$2,519,250.00 IN
FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS 75% OF THE PROJECT COST)**

WHEREAS, the contract authorized under Resolution No. 1994-55 for (General Trades) Project 24D2 - Renovation of West Park Rapid Station in the amount of three million two hundred five thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$3,205,00.00) with Ozanne Construction Company located at 1635 E. 25th Street, Cleveland, Ohio 44114 has been terminated by mutual agreement; and

WHEREAS, the bid of Schirmer Construction Company located at 4197 W. 150th Street, Cleveland, Ohio 44135 in the amount of three million three hundred fifty nine thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$3,359,000.00) was the second low bid after Ozanne Construction for General Trades bids received for Project 24D2 on March 4, 1994; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Schirmer Construction Company to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Schirmer Construction Company for the provision of general trades construction services for the Renovation of the West Park Rapid Station, be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.


Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Schirmer Construction Company to provide (General Trades) construction services for Project 24D2 - Renovation of the West Park Rapid Station.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of Capital Grant OH-03-0104 in the amount of three million three hundred fifty nine thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$3,359,000.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1993-88; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
